## STAFF AND STUDENTS: THE NEW ISOLATION RULES FROM JANUARY 3, 2022

### TEACHER, STAFF AND STUDENTS OVER 12 YEARS OLD

#### WITH FULL VACCINATION

Positive  
case

- Isolation for 5 days if the antigen test or PCR carried out on the 5th day is negative and in the absence of a symptom for 48 hours
- Isolation for 7 days otherwise

contact  
case

- No isolation
- Immediate antigenic test or PCR
- Autotest on D + 2, D + 4\*

#### WITHOUT VACCINATION OR WITH INCOMPLETE VACCINATION

- Isolation for 7 days if the antigen test or PCR carried out on the 7th day is negative and in the absence of a symptom for 48 hours
- Isolation for 10 days otherwise

- 7 days isolation
- Antigenic test or PCR after isolation

### STUDENT UNDER 12

#### WHATEVER THEIR VACCINATION STATUS

Positive  
case

- Isolation for 5 days if the antigen test or PCR carried out on the 5th day is negative and in the absence of a symptom for 48 hours
- Isolation for 7 days otherwise

contact  
case

- The student will be able to stay in class
- if the PCR or antigen test carried out on day 0 is indeed negative
- And if the self-tests carried out on J +2 and J +4 are negative (certificate on the honor of the parents)

\* D = day when you learn that you are in contact
